



GARBAGE/RECYCLING AUTOMATION

What Should I Know?


1. Collection Routes – For the time being, all collection routes will remain the same. Recycling collection will **not** be affected; it will remain every other week. All garbage and recycling is to be placed out by 7:00 A.M. on the day of your scheduled pickup. Nothing should be placed out for pickup prior to 3:00 P.M. the day before your scheduled pickup. If your garbage and/or recycling is not out when the City truck comes by for pickup, it will not return, and your garbage/recycling will have to wait for your next pickup date.

2. Cart Placement – Please take a moment to view the illustration to the right. Residents are asked to put their cart(s) at the edge of their driveway. If your driveway faces the City Street, **BOTH** carts will be picked up from the street. If your driveway faces the alley, **BOTH** carts will be picked up in the alley. Please note that carts need to be placed at least three (3) feet from any obstruction, such as a mailbox, power pole, fire hydrant, vehicle, or another cart. Please, **DO NOT** put containers in the roadway. The new collection truck has an 8-foot arm that can reach out and “grab” your cart safely from a short distance.

3. Collection Times – With the use of these carts, the amount of time required to collect refuse will be reduced. Accordingly, all carts need to be placed out for collection by 7 AM.

4. Acceptable Items – Garbage: Only materials stored inside the garbage cart will be collected. If you routinely have excess garbage, you may want to consider buying a larger cart or buy a second one, if necessary. Large items such as furniture and appliances will have to be disposed of at the owner’s expense. 5. Acceptable Items – Recyclables: If your recyclable material won’t fit inside your recycling cart, you may set it next to your cart in a clear, or transparent blue bag and it will be collected. The City of Baraboo single-streams recyclables. **All** recyclable materials can be placed inside the cart, bagged, or unbagged. If you routinely have excess recycling, you may want to consider buying a larger cart or a second one for your convenience.
