The meeting was called to order by Chairman John Alt at 12:00PM CST., with roll call and noting compliance with the Open Meetings Law.

Moved by Ellington to approve the minutes of September 3, 2018, seconded by Alt and unanimously carried.

Motion by Ellington to approve agenda, seconded by Alt and unanimously carried.

Review and recommendation to amend §12.03(7)(a)2 of the Baraboo Municipal Code to eliminate the license bond requirement for secondhand article and jewelry dealers.

Chief Schauf began with mentioning the recent change in the Code for Leads Online. Businesses began applying for licenses. We soon realized there was some confusion with our Code. Part of the confusion was requiring a surety bond for a second-hand dealer. A surety bond by State Statute is only required for pawn shops. The surety bond ensures the City is compensated for things, if rules are not followed. We currently have something in place in lieu of the surety bond. We will be able to go after any business in the form of a citation. Our current Code also allows for punishment by issuing code violations and by taking away licenses.

Therefore, the recommendation is to take the surety bond language out of our Code for second-hand dealers and leave it in for pawn shops.

Motion to recommend to the Council to change the City Code by Ellington, seconded by Alt and unanimously carried.

Review and recommendation to allow the City Administrator to submit the Notification of General Schedules Adoption form to the Historical Society and, upon approval by the Historical Society, allow the City Attorney to submit to the Common Council an amendment to §1.60 of the Baraboo Municipal Code stating that the City has adopted the Schedule.

City Administrator Geick stated that this request stems back to earlier work Cheryl Giese and Emily Truman started in getting the City records sorted requiring some filings to be made with the Historical Society. There has been a change in the law for records. The recommendation today will take into consideration all the changes and allow the City Administrator to work with the City Clerk and City Attorney to submit records.

Motion by Ellington to recommend to the Council to change the City Code, seconded by Alt and unanimously carried.

The next meeting will be December 10, 2018 at 12:00PM CST. Meeting location will be 101 South Boulevard. Moved by Ellington to adjourn, seconded by Ellington and unanimously carried. Meeting adjourned at 12:09PM CST.

A letter was prepared and hand delivered by the Police Department to residents adjacent to the property at 727 Walnut Street, Baraboo WI, 53913 where Juergen Beyer resides. The letter included a copy of the agenda for the December 10, 2018 meeting; residents were invited to attend.

11-11-2018

To the Baraboo Administrative Board

Hello. My name is Juergen Beyer, a.k.a J.B.. I am the home owner at 727 Walnut St. Recently my wife and I became aware of a complaint filed against us that we have 3 dogs on the property. Up until this point, we were unaware of the 2 dog limit in Baraboo. Let me describe a little about myself and my background including what brought me to the state of Wisconsin. I was born in Germany, migrated to Canada and then to California. My wife Sheila and I married very young and I enlisted in the United States Air Force. After my enlistment we moved to Arizona. We remained there until we moved to the State of Oregon, to a small town of about 800. I gained employment as the City Superintendent where I remained until I decided to pursue other avenues. I gained employment at a large company called Sonoco. A few years into my employment with them, the company decided to close our location and move those jobs elsewhere. We were offered a severance package or transfer to their facility in Texas. I had no desire to move to Texas so I took the severance and continued to look for work. As the weeks and months went on, it was becoming apparent that maybe our time in Oregon was drawing to a close. My daughter Trisha had been trying to convince us to come out East to Wisconsin. So that spring, I loaded myself, my clothes and my fishing poles in my Bronco and began the 2 day drive to Wisconsin, leaving my wife behind to continue her job as a waitress while I looked for work in Wisconsin. My daughter gladly took me in, rearranging her life and home to accommodate. I found employment at Teel Plastics and the Sears. My daughter sold her home in the Dells and we moved to North Freedom, to a home that would accommodate her 2 dogs as well as the 2 dogs my wife and I had at the time. In September, we were finally able to fly my wife and my dogs out here. My wife gained employment at Wal-Mart and after some time I gained employment at Seneca Foods and have now been there 6 years. My daughter has been at Seneca for over 17 years currently. She married and had my grandson, remained in North Freedom and my wife and I moved into Baraboo. My daughters' marriage went south and her and my grandson needed a place to go so they moved in with us. I had lost my 2 dogs due to old age by this point. I also had lost 2 dogs after due to unforeseeable circumstances. I have always had a dog since leaving the services and was heartbroken. My current lab mix, Ace, was a gift from my daughter. When her and my grandson needed a place to live, it was a no brainer that they would move in with us. The thought of having 3 dogs in the home never crossed any of our minds. That is why we are in this situation and writing to you. We are the only family we have. My mother is 81 and is in Arizona along with my 38 year old daughter, who is also in Arizona. My daughter can by no means afford to support herself and my grandson on her own. She has a nearly 4 year old special needs dog who is a hound mix. He likes to warn us there are rabbits and/or squirrels in the yard or others yards. We most definitely shush him or bring him in the house. We had the "back 40" (as my grandson calls it), cleared out this summer. That has drastically reduced the number of rabbits in our yard. Her other dog is a 10.5 year old retriever and is an emotional support dog. He has been through everything with her and my grandson will proudly tell you he is his Best Buddy. She just recently was told by the UW Vet Clinic that

Jake has Laryngeal Paralysis, to which there is no cure. It is a progressive neurological disease which will eventually rob him of his ability to breathe. All dogs progress differently with this disorder so it is a watch and see type of thing at this moment. My dog is Ace. He is an 18 month old lab mix. We have had him since he was 7 weeks old. We cannot bear to re-home any of these dogs. They are family. Our home sits on nearly ¾ of an acre, most all of which is the backyard. We have more than enough room for all 3 dogs. We have absolutely no intention of bringing anymore dogs into the home. When we lose one, we will also not bring another into the home. Our intention is to remove and thin out the trees that remain on our backyard and install a chain link/wooden fence. Our intent was to do that this summer but had a severely leaking roof we had to replace. I worked for the city Wastewater Department in Arizona for 15+ years and was the City Superintendent for Oakland, OR for a few years. I fully understand city ordinances and why they exist. I also understand there are sometimes exceptions to the norm. I am asking for our family to be one of those exceptions. We love this town and are so extremely grateful to our daughter in our time of need that we wish to be there for hers. This includes our dogs. We most definitely want to remain in Baraboo as well. All 3 dogs are current on all vaccines. They are all city licensed and have dog park licenses. My daughter and grandson take part in many city events and activities including the Annual Doggie Dip. Please contact me with any further questions you may have. Thank you for your time and consideration in the delicate matter.

To Whom It May Concern;

I am writing this letter in the hopes to be granted an exemption to the city ordinance of 2 dogs per household. Due to a bad marriage, divorce and lots of debt I am left with while raising my 6 year old son, he and I, along with our 2 dogs had to move in my parents as we had nowhere else to go. My only other family member is my sister who lives in Arizona. Most paychecks I am left with \$50 - \$80 to try and help pay for things at my parents, support my son and my dogs. We were unaware of the 2 dog limit. I have a hound mix who is special needs. He only barks at the squirrels and rabbits or if the dogs are playing. We never allow him to just bark and bark and bark. We either silence him or make him come back in the house. All 3 dogs are inside dogs. They are all neutered, current on vaccines and rabies, city licensed and have dog park licenses. We do however, have a house on the other side with 2 small dogs that bark incessantly when outside. There is also the house across the street and when they put their dogs outside, one of them tends to bark nonstop. My mother and I work dayshift so we are not even home until after 5pm. My father works graveyard, so he is in bed by 1230pm. The dogs are in the house from then until evening. We do not leave them outside. One evening per week, we dog sit my dad's dogs' sister so they can all go to doggie daycare the next day. They may do some barking while playing, but again, I remove my talker from the mix and bring him in the house. I used to be a foster mom through a rescue and we treat our dogs very well and are respectful of our neighbors also. I cannot change my past, nor the circumstances which brought my son and I to this place in our lives. My nearly 11 year old senior dog is my emotional support dog. I have had him since he was 9 months old. He and I have been through everything together. My other dog Jaxson is special needs. My dad lost his last 2 dogs under extremely tough situations. Honestly, we could not re-home any of them. I don't know where my son and I would go with our dogs. I cannot afford to live on my own while paying off all this debt. I also know that most people do not even allow dogs to renters, especially not 2 of them. That is why I am writing to you. I am looking to please be granted an exemption to the 2 dog ordinance. I cannot break my son's heart by re-homing one of our dogs but I don't want to be homeless either. Like I said earlier, all 3 dogs are current on all vaccines, neutered, have city and dog park licenses. They go to doggie daycare. I take part in the Paws Walk, the Otter Walk and many of the Parks and Rec Programs. I promise to continue to keep all dogs current and abide by whatever laws you impose and will not bring any other dogs into the home. When the time comes to say goodbye to one of them, we will not bring another into the home either. My dogs are safe and love everyone. I have even already started to take further steps to try and control Jaxsons' "hound mouth". If there were no squirrels or rabbits in our yard, you would never even hear him unless playing. I have never contacted the police department nor have I ever been a contact of the police department. Our family is very law abiding and very compassionate. Our dogs are part of our family. That is why I am writing to you. We don't have records, we don't cause any problems, we just keep to ourselves. We just need each other. I thank you from the bottom of my heart for your consideration in this matter and I eagerly look forward to hearing from you.





