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**The Programs / Activities in this guide are not school sponsored. The Baraboo School District does not fund or endorse them in any way.**

*You have three Convenient Ways to Register:*

## 1. Online

Our user friendly online registration system is available 24/7 to bring you a convenient registration experience. Simply visit our website at:

**In the upper right corner, choose the Red “Register for Recreation Programs Online” link.** This will take you to our program registration site. Simply follow the instructions on the screen to log in with your username and password, if you are a returning customer or to set up your *NEW* family account. New accounts must be verified for residency status. This is done only during our regular business hours!

## 2. Mail-In/Drop Off

Simply choose the programs that your children are interested in, fill out the registration form from page 22 of this flyer or located at the above website, enclose payment and drop off or mail to:

Stop in the office, prior to the listed registration deadline and we will be happy to register you at that time, if space is available. Office hours are Monday thru Friday 7:30am-4:30pm.

## WHY RESIDENT/NON-RESIDENT

The Baraboo Parks & Recreation Department is supported with tax dollars paid by residents of the City of Baraboo, in addition to sponsorships and individual participation fees.

Those who reside in the Baraboo School District but outside the Baraboo City Limits are invited to participate, but are required to pay a slightly higher fee.

A non-resident is anyone who does not reside within the Baraboo City Limits.

Residency is based on your primary residence.

## REFUND POLICY

### Civic Center / Park Shelter Rentals –

In case of cancellations, we will make every effort to help you reschedule your function, as necessary. Refunds of 50% of the fee paid will be issued only when cancellations are received at least 7 days prior to your function in writing. **No refunds will be given within the 7 day timeframe. No Refunds due to weather.**

### Recreation Programs –

Prior to the registration deadline of any program, refunds will be issued as a credit to your household account for future use on any Parks & Recreation transaction. If a refund check is requested, 100% of fees paid minus a \$5 service fee will be issued.

**No Refunds will be issued after the Program Registration Deadline.**

## OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOL


The swimming pool is located in Campbell Park on South Boulevard and is open June 5 thru August 23, 2020. Further Information can be obtained by calling the pool at 355-2764 when it is open for the season. During poor weather, call the pool directly for operation status but weather cancellations will also be posted on our website & Facebook page.

**Open Swim – Daily 1:30-5pm & 6:30-8:30pm**  
**Family Night – Sundays 6:30-8:30pm**  
**Adult Swim – Mon.-Fri. 11:30am-1:15pm & 5-6:30pm**

**Pool Passes must be purchased online or at the Civic Center until the pool opens. After June 7<sup>th</sup> they can be purchased at the pool during open swim times. Proof of residency is required.**

## POOL RENTAL INFORMATION

The Campbell Park Outdoor Pool can be rented for private parties as follows:

**Daily: 8:30 pm - 10:00 pm**

**Saturdays: 11:30 am - 1:00 pm\***

(\*Except when a home swim meet is scheduled)

Rental fee: \$125, includes up to 3 lifeguards (depending on party size) A minimum 7 day notice is needed for all rentals.

No glass bottles, alcoholic beverages, smoking or animals are allowed in the pool area during private parties. Contact the pool office for a complete list of rules.

**All rentals must be made through the swimming pool office. Hours are Monday-Friday 9am-8pm as well as weekends 1-5pm & 6:30-8pm.**


## SWIMMING LESSONS

The Campbell Park Outdoor Pool offers swimming lessons following the latest American Red Cross Swimming and Water Safety Program.

The prerequisite for each level is the successful demonstration of skills from the preceding level, except for Level 1, which has no prerequisites.

**Swimming Lesson Fees (per session):**  
**City of Baraboo Residents - \$35**  
**Non Residents - \$45**

- ⇒ All Swimming Lesson Registrations are handled online, at the Civic Center office or by mail ONLY. – Lesson Registrations are not accepted at the pool. Lesson Registrations will not be accepted after the “Register Before” dates listed for each session. This allows us the necessary time to assign classes to the available instructors and complete the class lists.
- ⇒ You may sign your child/children up for no more than two lessons at a time. After completion of the first lesson, you may sign up for a third lesson either online or in the Park & Recreation Office at the Baraboo Civic Center.



**Swimming Lessons are held Monday–Thursday.**

**Each Friday will be a planned make-up day that will only be used if there are cancellations during the week.**

## PARENT & CHILD AQUATICS

Builds basic water safety skills for both parents and children, helping children ages 1 to 3 years become comfortable in the water so they are ready to learn to swim. These basic skills include adjusting to the water environment, showing comfort while maintaining a front or back position in the water and demonstrating breath control, including blowing bubbles or voluntarily submerging under water.

## LEARN – TO – SWIM

### Level 1 - Introduction to Water Skills:

Helps participants feel comfortable in the water and work on foundational swimming skills. *If your child is already comfortable completely submerging under-water and attempting to float and use arm and leg motions, you can start them in a Level 2 course.*

**Course Includes:** Breath control, submerging, open eyes under water & retrieve objects, front & back glides and back floats, tread water using arm & hand actions, staying safe around aquatic environments, recognizing emergencies and how to call for help.

## BARABOO DOG PARK

The Dog Park, located in Maxwell-Potter Conservancy at the intersection of Mill Race Drive and Hill Street, features a 3-acre fenced in off-leash exercise area for dogs. The park offers a separate area for puppies and small dogs, agility equipment and opportunities to socialize. There's also an ADA water fountain with dog bowl available for users.

**Permits are valid Jan. 1-Dec. 31. Annual permits are available at the City Hall, at 101 South Blvd.**

Resident Annual Permit = \$20 per dog

Daily Permit = \$3 per dog

**Daily permits are required if you do not hold an annual permit. Daily permit fees can be paid at the dog park's self registration station located near the front entrance.**



## BARABOO COMMUNITY GARDENS

Located in Attridge Park on 2nd Avenue near the zoo, the Community Gardens offers garden plots to community residents. We have some exciting changes, with more raised beds added in 2020 and new soil for better garden production! Also new this year, the Sauk County Master Gardeners will be hosting Saturday morning Garden Talks throughout the summer, free for all gardeners! Topics will include everything from tomatoes to inserts, as well as a presentation on bee keeping and honey production.

**Garden Talks will be held Saturday mornings in June, July and August. All members will receive a schedule of when topics are scheduled.**



All garden plot rentals are good from May 1 - October 31 and include shared use of garden tools, water (with hoses available to share) and attendance at the NEW Saturday morning Garden Talks.

Garden Plots are available on a first come-first served basis with a limit of 2 plots per address. Costs to reserve a plot are \$15, or two plots for \$25.

## Park Regulations Notes:

Recently, the City of Baraboo made some changes to park regulations that you need to be aware of. These changes were made to improve the atmosphere of our parks and the safety of our visitors. Some of those changes include:

- **NO SMOKING OR VAPING**

*Smoking and vaping are not allowed in any parks or park facilities including the Civic Center, zoo and the Riverwalk.*

- **NO ALCOHOL IN THE FOLLOWING PARKS:**

*Campbell, Myron, Nanny, Liston Dog Park, Hackett Hollow Conservancy or anywhere on the Riverwalk.*

*Beer and wine are allowed (no glass) when responsibly consumed in accordance with state and local laws and ordinances.*

- **NO DOGS IN PARKS**

*Dogs are only allowed free in Liston Dog Park and Deppe Park. They are allowed on the Riverwalk if on a leash. Dogs are not permitted on the Arboretum Path.*

## OCHSNER PARK ZOO

The Ochsner Park Zoo is open year-round. Spring & Fall hours are 9am-5pm. Summer hours are from 9am-7pm. No admission is charged, however donations are always appreciated. A concession stand offers treats during hot summer days.



The Zoo currently features Grey Wolves, Llamas, Black Bear, Canada Lynx, American Beaver, Capuchin Monkeys, River Otters, Arctic Fox, Prairie Dogs, Emu, Dwarf Goats, Pot-Bellied Pigs, Great Horned Owls, Snowy Owls, Chickens, Barred Owls, White Tail Deer, Sandhill Cranes, Sulcotta & Russian Tortoises, Snakes, Skunk, Geese & Ducks.

The zoo is a USDA-licensed facility and a member of the Wisconsin Municipal Zoo Associates.





- ◇ **Park Hours** are 6am-10pm. Dog Park hours are dusk to dawn. Zoo summer hours are 8:30am-7:30pm. It is unlawful for anyone to be in a park outside of these hours, except with written permission from the Parks and Recreation Director or when participating in a department-sponsored program.
- ◇ **Pets** are not allowed on park property unless on a path/trail with lease or in the Dog Park. No dogs are allowed in the arboretum including the path. It is the dog-handlers responsibility to clean up after their dogs.
- ◇ **Glass** containers, firearms or fireworks are not allowed on any park property.
- ◇ **NO SMOKING** or vaping in any City parks or facilities.
- ◇ **Fires** are only allowed in grills or fireplaces. You must provide your own firewood.
- ◇ **Tents**, volleyball, bounce houses or any types of stakes are not permitted on the grounds without prior approval.
