MINUTES FOR: Special Meeting on April 30, 2019

The Baraboo Police & Fire Commission (PFC) met on this date at the Baraboo Municipal Building, 101 South Boulevard, room #214, Baraboo, WI. The meeting was opened at 8:30am by PFC President Paul Kujak. A notice of this 'Amended' meeting was posted on April 29, 2019.

Roll call found Commissioners Alt, Getschmann, Kluge, Kujak and Madalon were in attendance (Alt remained in Room 205 for the Opening).

Others in attendance for portions of the meeting were Police Chief Schauf, School Administrator Lori Miller, and Lt Travis Hilliard as well as the candidates.

Compliance with the open meeting law was noted by Kujak.

Kujak made a request to have the 'Amended' Agenda approved, and presented the Amendment to include the hiring of a new Police Officer by Chief Schauf.

- Getschmann made a Motion to approve the Amendment; Madalon offered a second and the Motion carried 4-0. [Note: Alt was in room 205.]
- Getschmann made a Motion to approve the Amended Agenda; Madalon offered a second and the Motion carried 4-0. [Note: Alt was in room 205.]

There was no one to comment under 'Public Comments'.

Kujak announced that the Commission will meet in CLOSED SESSION as per Wis. Stats. 19.85(1)(c) to consider employment, promotion, compensation or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility and as per 19.85(1)(e) to deliberate or negotiate the purchasing of public properties, the investing of public funds, or to conduct other specific public business, whenever competitive or bargaining reasons require a Closed Session. The purpose of the closed session was to conduct interviews of candidates for the position of Baraboo Police School Resource Officer.

- Kluge made a Motion to approve; Getschmann offered a second and the Motion carried 4-0. [Note: Alt was in room 205.]

Note: The Commission then moved to Room 205 for the interviews.

Kujak announced that the Commission will reconvene in OPEN SESSION as per Wis. Stats. 19.85(2) to address any business that may be the result of discussion conducted in Closed Session to this point.

- Alt made a Motion to approve; Getschmann offered a second and the Motion carried 5-0.

Under NEW BUSINESS:

Chief Schauf presented a letter requesting to decertify any and all prior Baraboo School Resource Officer eligibility lists, and certify a new Baraboo School Resource Officer eligibility list - that contains the names of: Mark Creighton, Jessica Pichler and Amanda Sabol.

- Getschmann made a Motion to approve; Alt offered a second and the Motion carried 5-0.

Mr Wepking has participated in a series of tests and interviews as a part of the ongoing selection process. His hiring will occur only after successful completion of a medical evaluation, psychological examination, and will be presented for approval by the City Administrator.

- Getschmann made a Motion to approve; Alt offered a second and the Motion carried 5-0.

- Madalon made a motion to adjourn the meeting; Kluge offered a second. Motion passed 5-0.
